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WORLD GTL TO PRESENT AT GAS TO LIQUIDS 2007 CONFERENCE

New York, NY—October 26, 2007 -- World GTL (WGTL), a leading producer and operator of small of gas-to-liquid (“GTL”) plants, announced today that it is scheduled to present at the Gas to Liquids 2007 Conference, on October 30-31, 2007 at the Waldorf Hilton in London, England.

David Loring, President and Chief Executive Officer of World GTL, will be presenting at the conference on October 31 at 9:10AM. The presentation, titled, “The Future of GTL” will focus primarily on industry trends and the economic potential of undersized stranded gas fields.

The conference will highlight the technology, latest developments, and commercialization of the gas to liquids (GTL) industry. The GTL process converts non-commercial hydrocarbons into the world’s cleanest, most environmentally friendly liquid fuels. It has zero sulfur, zero aromatics and is biodegradable. GTL exceeds all present and planned government regulations for emissions.

As the [a] leader in building small GTL plants, WGTL identifies remote, shut-in natural gas deposits that are promising development candidates for applying GTL technology.

Currently, World GTL Trinidad Limited, a joint venture between World GTL Inc and the Petroleum Company of Trinidad and Tobago (“Petrotrin”), the Government-owned integrated petroleum company, is constructing the first commercial gas-to-liquid facility in the Americas. The plant is anticipated to be fully operational in 2008.
